Virtual Alumni Meet (Platform - Google meet):

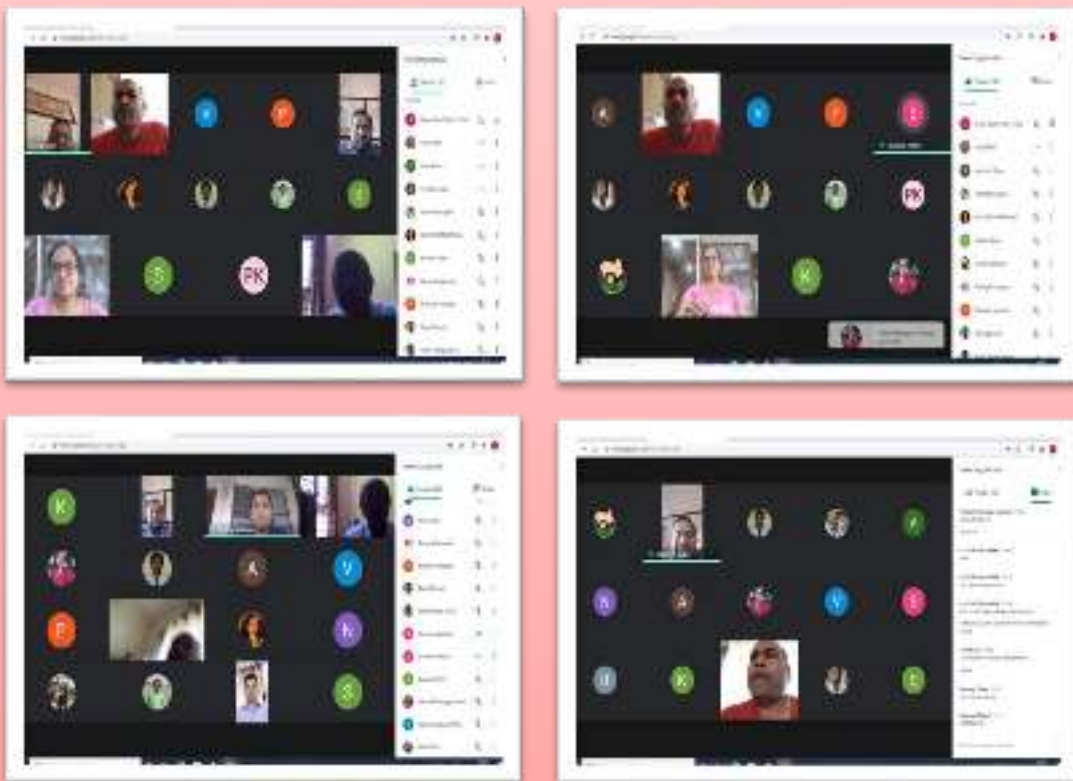
